Speaking of membership, have you renewed yours for 2025? You can find a membership form on the club website and either mail it in or submit it online.



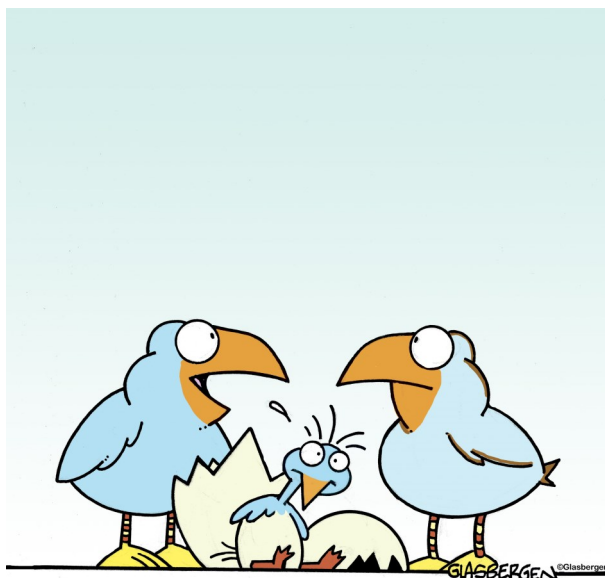
